Why would I appeal?

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You can appeal the assessed value of your home for any of the following reasons:

Lack of Uniformity

✓ The assessed value of your property is not in line with other similar properties in your neighborhood.

Over-valuation

✓ The proposed assessed valuation of your property is higher than its actual price.

Property Description Error

- ✓ There is an error in the description of your property that adversely effects the proposed assessed valuation of your property.
- ✓ Your property has been damaged by fire, flood, or other casualty and/or part of all of the building has been demolished.

Others

✓ You may have other grounds to appeal specific to your property.

How do I appeal? Appealing your Assessment at the Board of Review

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What you need to appeal?

- A completed Board of Review complaint form.
- All forms can be found at any of the six Board of Reviews offices throughout the county or online at www.CookCountyBoardOfReview.com.

Where do I submit my appeal?

To Appeal Online:

Visit <u>www.CookCountyBoardOfReview.com</u> and enter your Property Identification Number (PIN).

* When filing an appeal on CookCountyBoardOfReview.com: you may file your appeal at anytime online even if your township is not open. Once your township is open by the Board of Review, your appeal will be reviewed.

To Appeal by Mail:

Complete an official Complaint Form

(http://CookCountyBoardOfReview.com/assets/pdfs/complaint.pdf) and mail it to: Cook County Board of Review, 118 North Clark Street Room #601, Chicago Illinois 60602 *please write "COMPLAINT FORM" on the envelope.

To Appeal in Person:

Visit any of the six Board of Review offices located in Chicago (City Hall), Bridgeview, Markham, Maywood, Rolling Meadows, and Skokie.

What happens after I submit my appeal?

- **Hearing**: you can request a hearing with the Board of Review's staff to present your case and any substantial evidence.
- If you decline your right to a hearing: you will be mailed the Board of Review's decisionafter analysis.
